FMU invites sealed bids (technical and financial proposals sealed in separate envelopes) from eligible bidders for “**Maintenance & Support of Data Centre and Server Upgrade**” as per details mentioned in the “Technical Specification” in the Bidding Document.

Bidding will be conducted under Open Competitive Bidding pursuant to ‘Single Stage Two Envelopes procedure’ as per Rule 36(b) of Public Procurement Rules (PPR) 2004 and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the PPR 2004 that meet the following minimum eligibility/qualification criteria:

1. Bidder should not be blacklisted under the provision of Rule 19 of Public Procurement Rules 2004.
2. Bidder must not appear on NACTA list.
3. Bidder must be a PRINCIPAL or an authorized partner/agent of the PRINCIPAL in Pakistan; partner/agent should be in possession of a consistently valid PRINCIPAL’s authorization certificate as per the following:
 - a. Environment Systems : Not Applicable
 - b. Power Systems : Not Applicable
 - c. Server Systems : 5 Years or more
 - d. Network Systems : 5 Years or more
4. Bidders should have experience and documented track of similar assignments as per the following:
 - a. Environment Systems : 2 or more in last 3 years
 - b. Power Systems : 3 or more in last 2 years (UPS)
 - c. Server Systems : 3 or more in last 2 years (of same PRINCIPAL)
 - d. Network Systems : 3 or more in last 2 years (of same PRINCIPAL)
5. Bidders for UPS, Servers & Network must be authorized by the respective PRINCIPAL specifically for this Tender.
6. Bidder must have Annual Sales volume/Gross Turnover of 300 Million rupees or more in each of the last 03 (Three) years.
7. Bidder must have verifiable presence/support/branch offices in Karachi to provide support and must have technical strength of PRINCIPAL Certified/Trained Resources of the same OEM for UPS (2 resources or more), Servers (3 resources or more) & Network (3 resources or more) on permanent basis in Karachi.
8. Bidders must be registered with the relevant Federal and/or Provincial Tax Authorities and must also appear on the Active Taxpayer List (ATL) of the FBR.

The bidders are required to give their best and final prices as no negotiations are expected. The rates quoted must remain valid for a period of 180 (One Hundred and Eighty) days after opening of bids.

Interested eligible bidders may obtain an electronic (soft) copy of the bidding documents upon submission of a written application to the address below and payment of a non-refundable fee of Rs.2,500/- (Rupees Two thousand five hundred only), through deposit in Government Treasury Account (receipt should be provided) during working hours after publication of this IFB till closing thereof. This IFB is also being uploaded on the websites <http://www.ppra.org.pk> and <http://www.fmu.gov.pk>. The interested bidder may bring along a USB flash drive to obtain the soft copy of the bidding documents or may request bidding documents to be emailed. Bids will only be accepted from the bidders who obtain the Tender Documents, after due process defined above.

Bid security of an amount **PKR.3,000,000/- (Rupees Three Million Only)** must be accompanied with the Technical Bid in a separate sealed envelope. Bidders have to submit complete requirements for the bids. Late bids will be rejected. Bids submitted without signed Bid Form by authorized nominee of the bidder will be rejected. Bid with material deviation, exception, objection, conditionality, or reservation will also be rejected.

Sealed Bids must be delivered at the office of the undersigned on or before **Friday, February 18, 2022, at 11:00 AM**. Bids will be opened, in the presence of bidders’ representatives who choose to attend, at **11:30 AM same day** at FMU Office.
